

Educational Activities at Home — Learning Games Ages 2-8

Learning doesn't need a classroom. These games build language, logic, emotional skills and fine motor control — without feeling like school.

Language Games (2-5 yrs)

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| ☐ Rhyme hunt: find 3 things that rhyme | ☐ Picture description: name 5 things you see |
| ☐ Story cubes: 3 dice = invent a story | ☐ Sound search: find something that starts with B |

Logic & Counting (4-7 yrs)

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| ☐ Kitchen maths: '3 + 2 = how many?' | ☐ Sorting game: by colour / size / shape |
| ☐ Pattern making: red-blue-red — what comes next? | ☐ Size guess: elephant or car? |

Pro-Tip Ask, don't correct: 'Why did you sort them that way?'

Emotional Intelligence (3-8 yrs)

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| ☐ Draw feeling faces: happy, sad, angry, tired | ☐ Gratitude circle: each person shares 1 thing they're thankful for |
| ☐ Apology role-play: practice saying sorry | ☐ Emotion story: character is scared — help them together |

Tip HuggleTales emotion stories: joy, fear, sadness and anger — playfully.

Fine Motor & Creativity (3-7 yrs)

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| ☐ Glue stick + cotton bud = dot painting | ☐ Scissor practice: straight lines, circles, shapes |
| ☐ Bead threading + pattern making | ☐ Box castle: glue boxes together + colour in |
